There are two classrooms, a fully automated and up-to-date library and a new office and administration area. We also have 5 laptops and 4 PC's, digital and video cameras and a data projector available as quality learning and teaching tools for students. Internet is available in all classrooms. The school is well equipped with a wide range of learning resources. Other facilities include a swimming pool, adventure playground, rugby field, tennis court, and sandpit set in attractive surroundings. All of this is alongside a Community Hall.
